# MONTHLY SAFETY TOPIC:

Our Monthly Safety Topic is **Mealtime Success**. This month we focus on how to provide structured meal times for happy and healthy young children. Are you a family looking to transition your child onto solid foods?

Every child is different, but all families should consider the following before starting solid foods. Is you child able to keep his/her tongue in their mouth most of the time? Does your child watch you eat and act like he/she would like to do the same? Can your child remain in a sitting position without falling forward or to the side?

Infants can typically do these three things by the age of 4-6 months. Remember to always check your infant's cues before starting solid foods! Remember to check parent communication boards for more information on this important topic. Happy eating!
