PA HARVEST OF THE MONTH

Leafy Greens is our PA Harvest of the Month for April. Did you know that Kale can range in colors from white to green, yellow to blue, and even at times violet? Collard greens, mustard greens, and turnip greens are among the most popular items of US cuisines. When storing lettuce, it should be stored as close to 32 degrees Fahrenheit. To keep lettuce safe to consumer, it should not be frozen or stored in dry areas. Lettuce should be used as soon as possible since it is a perishable.

Monthly Safety Topic: Mental Health in Young Children

Our Safety topic for April is Mental Health Awareness in Early Childhood and Mindfulness. Mental health awareness is important in early childhood for helping children to develop resilience and coping skills. Mental health awareness helps to create a supportive learning environment where children can express their emotions in a safe space and safe manner. As adults we are models to children to show healthy behaviors and create routines. Routines help to provide structure and stability to young children. In the classroom and at home, we may provide creative outlets where children can express their emotions. Early intervention is there to help children to manage challenges and improve overall skills presented by the child. LifeSpan partners with IvyRehab and the Bucks County Intermediate Unit (BCIU) to provide additional supports for those who qualify.
