Swimming season is upon us and while we are excited to splish and splash in our pools, it is critical for parents and children to be aware of water safety guidelines to prevent potential injuries. Drowning is the No. 1 cause of death in children, besides birth defects.

1. **SUPERVISION:** Never leave a child unattended near water.
2. **CHOOSE A BRIGHT COLORED BATHING SUIT:** Easy to spot in water! Avoid BLUE SUITS!
3. **SWIM LESSON:** Swim lessons are supported by American Red Cross for children 4 and older or for children ages 1-4 if parents think they are ready.
4. **POOL GATES/FENCES/ALARM:** Gates, Fences and alarms leading to a pool area can deter a child wandering near the area and alert others that a child may be in danger.
